Early Development Instrument

The Early Development Instrument (EDI) is a 104-question checklist measuring children's readiness to learn at school before entry to Grade 1. The EDI was developed by Dan Offord and Magdalena Janus at the Offord Centre for Child Studies, McMaster University in 1998, and finalised in 2000.

Since 1999 EDI data has been collected for over 200,000 4-5 year old children in Canada and beyond. This document provides a set of normative data on the EDI domains based on a community-representative subgroup of the current database collected over the past five years in Canada.

Databases description

Basic sample

Several criteria in terms of data quality had to be applied in order to identify the subgroup for the normative, "gold standard", sample. First, only children attending the Senior Kindergarten year (entry at 5 years of age) were included. Second, for communities that participated more than once over the 5-year period, the fullest or the most recent implementation was included. This group of 132,176children made the "basic sample". The breakdown of children by year and province in the basic sample is in Table 1.

Full sample

The next step in ensuring the reliability of data was to restrict the sample by excluding the following: 1) missing or out of appropriate range age, 2) missing gender, and 3) missing two or more domains. These limitations resulted in a sample of 125,282, a 94.7% of the basic sample. Table 2 shows the breakdown of thus selected full sample. Table 3 provides the frequencies of demographic variables for the full sample. The domain intercorrelations are provided in Table 4.

The statistics for the EDI domains are in Table 5. Mean, standard deviation, and 10th, 25th, 50th, 75th, and 90th percentiles are listed. (Please note that since one domain was allowed to be missing, the total Ns per domain are not equal.)

"Gold Standard" normative sample

The final restriction of the sample was carried out by including only children who did not have the "Special Needs" status. This was done by selecting only children for whom the Special Needs variable was nonmissing and equal to 0. Children with missing data, and those who had a value of 1 on the variable were excluded. This resulted in the final sample of 116,860 children. This represents 93.3% of the full sample, and 88.4% of the basic sample.

An unfortunate side-effect of this restriction was that all communities for whom the <u>latest</u> implementation occurred in 2000 were removed, since the data on Special Needs status were not collected systematically until 2001. However, the only region that lost its representation from the normative sample due to this restriction was Nunavut. While this is regrettable, the number of children for whom there were EDI data was only 103, which was unlikely to affect the values for normative data in a significant way. Table 6 shows the breakdown by year and province for the Gold Standard normative sample. Table 7 provides the frequencies of demographic variables. Table 8 shows the domain intercorrelations.

The statistics for the EDI domains in the Gold Standard sample are in Table 9. Mean, standard deviation, and 10th, 25th, 50th, 75th, and 90th percentiles are listed.

Gold Standard detailed breakdowns

Table 10 contains the frequencies for the six age categories for whom detailed EDI statistics were calculated. 99.4% of children in the Gold Standard sample fit into these categories.

Tables 11 and 12 provide the statistics by gender. Tables 13-18 provide the statistics by age. Tables 19-30 provide the EDI statistics by age and gender. All tables include mean, standard deviation, 10th, 25th, 50th, 75th, and 90th percentiles for each of the five EDI domains.
